HOME LIBRARY SERVICE APPLICATION FORM

Who can use this service?

Any Western Downs resident who lives within the town boundary of a town with a Western Downs Libraries branch, and are unable to access a public library in person, including:

- People who have illnesses or disabilities which prevent them from accessing a library. These conditions may be temporary, recurring or permanent.
- People who are able to visit a library, but because of frailty or disability are unable to carry items home.
- People who live in residential establishments, such as nursing homes, hostels, supported-accommodation houses or hospitals.
- People who are engaged in full-time care for people.
- Young children who are in the care of any of the above groups.
- Others not included in the above but deemed suitable for home delivery at the discretion of library staff.

What if I live outside the town boundary?

For customers outside a town boundary, library staff can select items for you that can be collected by a friend or family member from your local branch. Please contact your local branch to arrange.
